

Is your chapter/club Fund Raising Properly?

Correct vs. Incorrect

When Fund Raising for the ΑΓΔ Foundation

Correct: “Proceeds from (name of event) will be used for diabetes research and education, scholarships and other Alpha Gamma Delta Foundation philanthropic programs.”

Correct: Your chapter/club should send **ONE** check made payable to the Alpha Gamma Delta Foundation for all the *proceeds from your event.

Correct: Funds must be raised in the name of the Alpha Gamma Delta Foundation and its philanthropies.

Correct: In your advertising, the words **NOT TAX DEDUCTIBLE** must appear in print larger than the text including the purchase price of an item, service or event.

Incorrect: “Proceeds from (name of event) are for JDRF, ADA or diabetes only.”

Incorrect: Collect donations or event registrations and send them directly to the Foundation.

Incorrect: Funds shall **NOT** come from collegiate dues or any type of assessment.

Incorrect: Advertising that any/all contributions to your fund raiser are tax deductible.

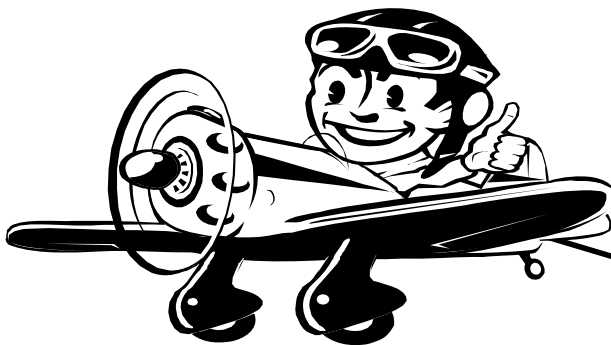
*Proceeds: the net amount received after deduction of your event expenses.

Fund Raising vs. Community Service

Fund Raising: is the organized activity of raising funds/money (for an institution).

Community Service: volunteering your time for the benefit of your community.
